About the Opportunity

The purpose of the Assistant Locomotive Operations Officer (ALOO) position is to provide support within Train Operations to assist in capacity building ensuring a pipeline of competent, skilled personnel are in place for daily train operations of Puffing Billy Railways' steam and diesel locomotives. This should be done in accordance with the organisations training regime, safe working procedures and business operations.

The ALOO position is full-time ongoing although there is flexibility to work on a part time basis. The position will support the delivery of competency-based training, both theoretical and practical to progress the training of engine cleaners, fireman and drivers. Focus will be on providing on-the-job practical instruction and supervision.

In addition, the ALOO will provide support as required to ensure scheduled operations are provided. These may include driving, firing and engine cleaning.
